Participation Rules

Deadline: September 9, 2026, 17:00 hrs, ET.

Thank you for your interest in submitting a proposal for **LASA2027: *Navegar el colapso: reinventar la política, cuidar lo común***, taking place June 16–20, 2027. When submitting proposals, please follow the five participation rules described below:

Rule 1: Participation limitation

- LASA2027 participants are limited to **one paper per Congress**, no exceptions. Participants who have submitted an individual proposal, may not be added to a panel proposal as paper presenter. Additionally, if a participant is a co-author, that paper counts as their only paper.
- Participants are limited to **four active roles per Congress**. Being an organizer or a contact person does not count toward these roles. The four active roles may take the form of:
 1. Paper presenter (in a panel)
 2. Presenter without paper (in a roundtable)
 3. Presenter without paper (in a workshop)
 4. Discussant (in a panel, workshop or roundtable)
 5. Chair (in a panel, workshop or roundtable)
- Panel proposals must have a minimum of three and a maximum of five papers. Workshop and roundtable proposals must have a minimum of three presenters (without paper), with no maximum.
- Panels, workshops and roundtables should have at least one chair (maximum two). The roles session organizer (maximum two) and discussant (maximum 1) are not mandatory, but highly recommended.

1. The rules for Section sessions are the same as for regular sessions.

Travel Grants

- LASA Travel Grants provide support for participants traveling to the Congress city. Therefore, only those attending LASA2027 **in-person**, in **Mexico City, Mexico**, are eligible to receive the discretionary travel grant.
- Travel grant requests can only be sent by the participant requesting the grant and can only be given to individuals who have an accepted paper in the Congress.
- Participants who received a travel grant at the LASA2024, LASA2025, or LASA2026 Congresses are not eligible to apply for a grant at the LASA2027 Congress. This includes candidates whose assigned grant was not used because they did not attend the Congress and did not cancel their participation, or because they canceled at the last minute, eliminating the opportunity for another participant to receive the grant.

Rule 2: Membership or All Access requirement

The following rules are related specifically to the type of proposal:

- **Individual submissions:** To submit a proposal and travel grant request, the LASA membership or All Access subscription (membership + congress registration with discount) of the individual submitter and co-author(s) must expire after September 9, 2026. Each co-author must send a separate travel grant request.
- **Panel submissions:** To be included in the proposal, the LASA membership or All Access subscription (membership + congress registration with discount) of all participants in the panel must expire after September 9, 2026. All panelists, as LASA members, can submit their individual travel grant requests.
- **Workshop or roundtable submissions:** To be included in the proposal, the LASA membership or All Access subscription (membership + congress registration with discount) of all participants must expire after September 9, 2026. No workshop or roundtable participants may request a travel grant unless they also have a paper in the Congress.
- **Section submissions:** All participants must have LASA memberships or have All Access subscriptions (membership + congress registration with discount) that expire after September 9, 2026, and must be current members of the specific Section in which they plan to participate. All paper presenters in a Section session, as LASA members, can submit their individual travel grant requests.

Please do not wait until the deadline (**September 9, 2026, 17:00 hrs, ET**) to become a member, renew your membership or All Access Subscription, or submit a proposal.

Rule 3: Congress preregistration

Once proposals have been approved, all participants are required to have their Congress

registration or All Access subscription (membership + congress registration with discount), valid until **June 21, 2027**, to participate.

Congress preregistration or All Access renewal must take place before **April 1, 2027, 17:00 hrs, ET**. Failure to register or renew All Access by this deadline will result in removal from the program. In addition, sessions may be cancelled or modified due to insufficient paper presenters.

Rule 4: Paper delivery

As a paper presenter, you have two important obligations:

- To ensure that the members of your session, especially discussants, receive your paper in time to read it carefully prior to the meeting; and
- To submit your paper for the Congress proceedings. Note: Your paper should not be considered published because it is posted on the LASA website.

Rule 5: Session schedule

The sessions will be scheduled between the morning of wednesday June 16, until the end of the day on Sunday, June 20, 2027. **Participants are expected to be available for presenting during this time.** Please note that scheduling change requests cannot be honored.
